- Ad hoc for non-profit status: 501(C)4 was revoked in 2018 and can get reinstated. But need to file taxes for the last 3 years. Needs to track down some cards sent from the IRS, probably Russ G. has it. Need to include a reason why at least one of those years was not filed. Can forego all of that if we instead apply for 501(C)3, we will need a CPA

and to pay the IRS \$600. Can pay a CPA as our Registered Agent for probably about \$160 per year. Main difference between 501(C)3 and 501(C)4 is that the former would give us sales tax exception. Sunee knows a CPA and will get a quote for his services in helping us. Also recommended that we get 2 other quotes. Zeb knows some CPAs from which we can get quotes.

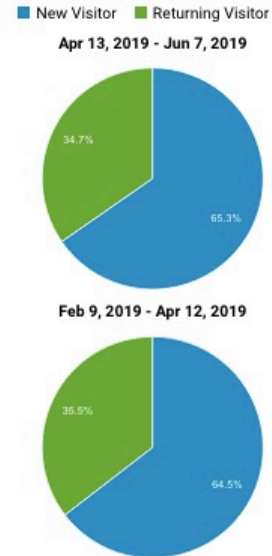
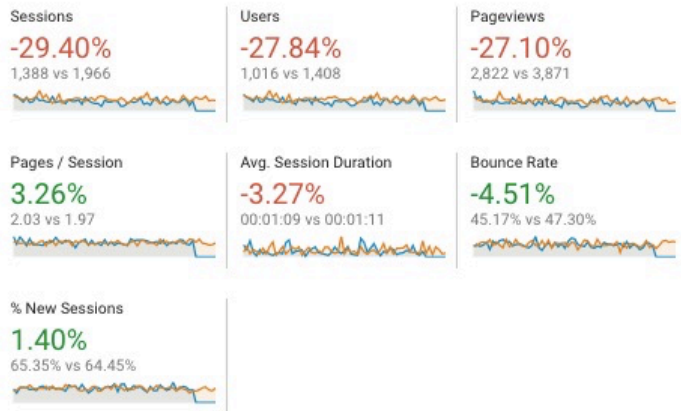
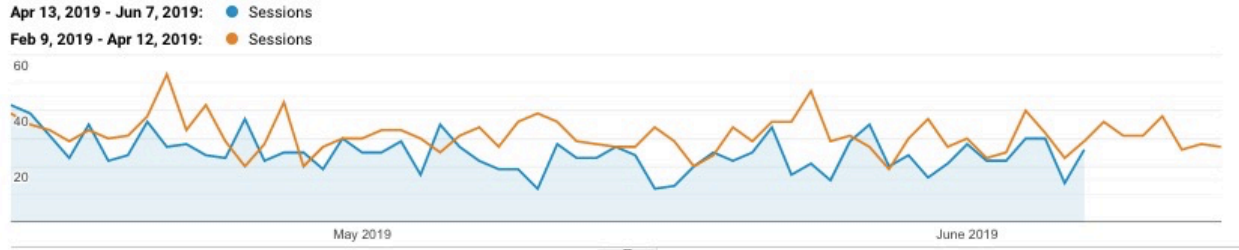
