## **Admin Reports:**

**Facilitator:** Steve – Went to the post office and it had moved, the key didn't work. Brittni dealt with this. We have a new set of keys because we don't know how long the building will be under construction. For the time being the mail will go the new post office and there was nothing there anyway.

Was going to get with RCM's and Phil to talk about Steps by Mail and will get some guidelines setup. Phil states he has a negative perspective about this, but it will be under the H&I commitment and Phil will take it off Steve's hands. Steve and Phil will work together to get on the same page.

We will try to stay on top of posting where the meetings will be since things are ever changing. We would like to be in person but, we can't promise that.

**Secretary:** Leska – Last months minutes will serve as my report. Thanks for sending me stuff so I could compile notes. I cannot promise my attendance at the October meeting.

**Regional Treasurer:** Brittini – Reported on PO Box and paid that for the next year \$284. Have a check for Justin B for Web hosting \$147. URICNA did reimbursement for storage unit. No bills for the next 6 months. Everything is squared away. We don't have a formal report currently, but Brittini will get it over within the next week. We have been getting \$1500 in checking, and \$500 in prudent so we are in good shape.

**Utah Regional Delegate Report:** James – Have been meeting as conference participants. We have the CP calls and it has been discussed as to what we want to do about WSC. The 2020 was partial and virtual. For 2022 most participants see a benefit of having an in person conference, although it is not practical. There is lots of discussion. We don't know at this point. Has World recovered financially? No, not really. The current possible option is (RCMs please discuss this) is having a one year delay and trying to hold in person in 2023 instead. There are a lot of challenges that some of the US delegates face that out of country people do not. We want to also have the option for hugs, the basis of the fellowship. What would make the most sense? How do we, as the Utah Region, feel? How would we navigate that, would we vote in a new team, or carry over the same delegates? There is a document at NA.org, for members, World Service Conference – 4 pg document that can give more info if you need it (James read some info from this document). James was asked of World has recovered, and generally speaking, the answer is no. Pretty basic, if each group in the US donated around \$40 once every other year, then we would be able to afford the conference.

RMZF – Rocky Mt Zonal Forum – it has become a little more disorganized while being virtual. Last one was hosted by Montana. James has been requesting that information is clear and that we are making information available. We are still working out who would be a contact for the Zone, rather than just a general information. The goal is to collaborate. The RD's are trying to be the contact, but there is a discussion about having a specific person to do that so we can communicate with the other zones. I have also asked that we don't try to make a bunch of decisions via email. There has been an overload. Have been staying in contact and on top of the info that comes our way. It is developing and it is an ongoing process. Hopefully we are maturing and growing.


Some small updates to some of the contact information for Areas on the Contact page was done, specifically UWANA's PO Box as well as the web link for Central to just point to the page on the Region website for Central.

Central's page was updated within the last month to their most current available meeting list (which was last updated in June, but sent to me late July or early August, so I assume that is current.) If not, just email an updated schedule to me and I can get that updated.

The Events page has been updated to remove the previous info for Campvention, I have some placeholders to post the location of it next year when that is known as well as information about when their committee meetings happen. Just let me know the schedule of those and that can be posted.

I also just updated the URICNA information on the page to move that to the top - the last flyer/info I got from that committee is the logo contest, so I took that down and just posted the date of it and a note that registration info will be available soon. So just let me know what flyers or other info needs to be posted and I'll get it on there.

Below are the analytics of the site for the past two months compared to the previous two months prior, e.g. Region meeting cycle to cycle. The chart shows week to week Sessions, with additional info broken down below that. It looks like we had a significant bump in views in the week before Campvention - which bumped the overall viewership quite a bit for this cycle. Otherwise, viewership was average.

## **Campvention:** James K –

Campvention 38 -2021

Event was a huge success and well attended. Aside from some inclement weather, people had a wonderful time and

filled their recovery cups (with the good ice). The speakers did a wonderful job, the talent show was fun and interesting,

and the raffle and auction were a blast. We had an excellent committee and several members stepped up and help out

with the event.

The event was held at Monte Cristo Campground near Woodruff, UT on July 30 – August 1, 2021. We reserved 34 sites

including the two group sites. All spots were full and we started to have concerns about the lack of parking and

available camp spots as the event wore on. The poor weather on Saturday afternoon forced many people to leave, but

those who stayed had an excellent Hawaiian BBQ dinner with plenty of sides.

Those who stayed Saturday night had an excellent midnight speaker and wonderfully entertaining Sunday morning

speaker as well of lots of hot coffee and Sunday breakfast. Also, the Saturday morning burrito breakfast was outstanding

and will be talked about for years to come... according to the cook.

All positions have been filled (with several co-chairs) and we are prepared to have the new chair Butts affirmed today.

Also, the Treasurer and Vice Chair will be present as needed to be affirmed. There will be a committee hand-off meeting

with the new and previous year members in near future.

The merchandise was amazing, and we sold out completely. Mugs, hats, tee shirts, hoodies, jogger pants, tote bags, and

stickers. We presold most items online prior to the event, then took the profit to order additional merchandise keeping

our overall merchandise risk at \$0. All merchandise sold at the event was pure profit. This is a great approach for other

committees that sell merchandise.

Lastly, there were some items that were damaged by the weather that we would like to replace and some items that

were in short supply. We are estimating about \$1,000 for these items including: Pop-up tents, coffee burners, garbage

cans, tables, and other small items. We can discuss this as needed with the RCMs.
