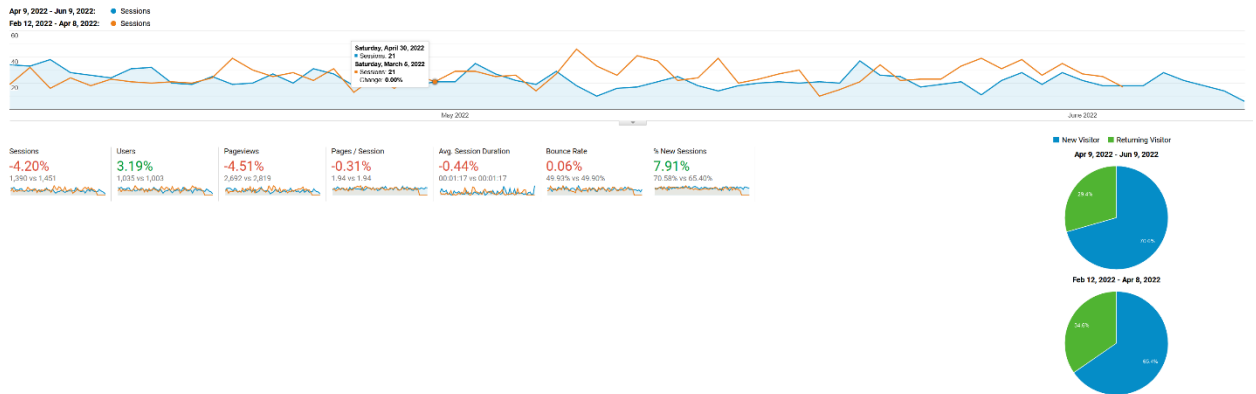

**Hospitals and Institutions Chair:** Phil – State Prison will have 6 libraries and they are planning on a 7<sup>th</sup> when they open. We don’t know when the opening will be but we would like to be prepared to donate literature. Judy Houser is the contact and Phil is working on it. Still no luck at the Gunnison Prison, they should have plenty of literature but I have not received a call from them. Reports has about \$500 now. Would like to spend about \$500 per library. We don’t know how the libraries will be split, if they will be per pod etc. We are just guessing when it will open, but currently they are delayed. Several of the workers from the Draper prison are

not wanting to work at the new facility so they are making it more difficult for us to get in because of the lack of staff.
