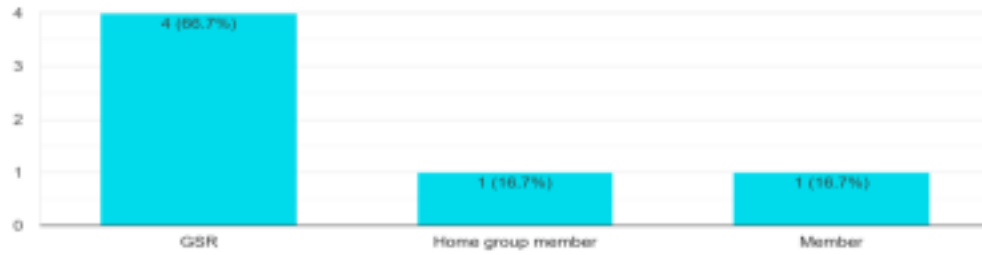
Utah Regional Delegate: Cody –

Campvention: Ryan –

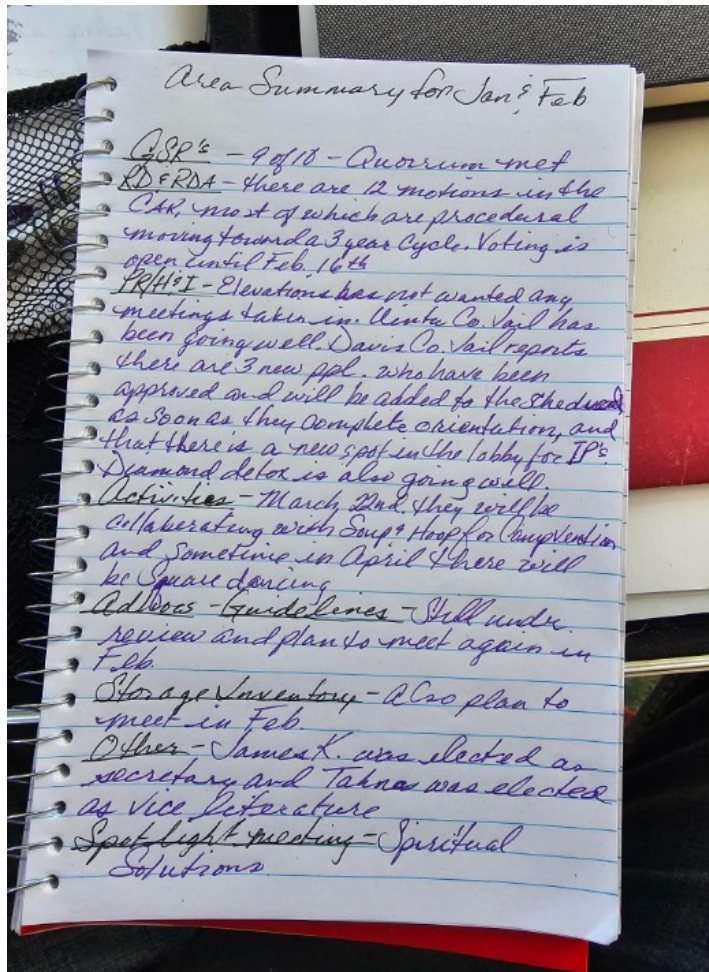
