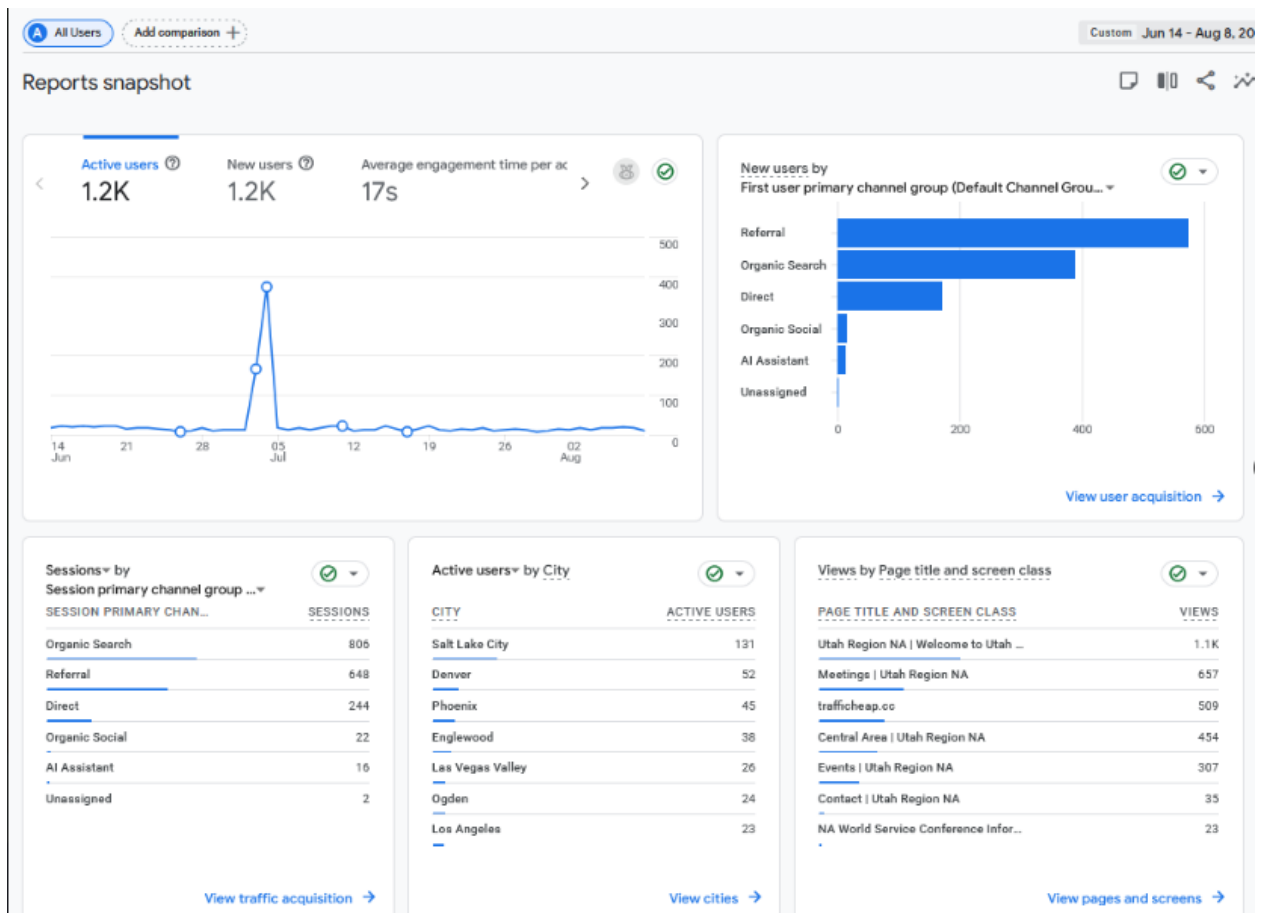

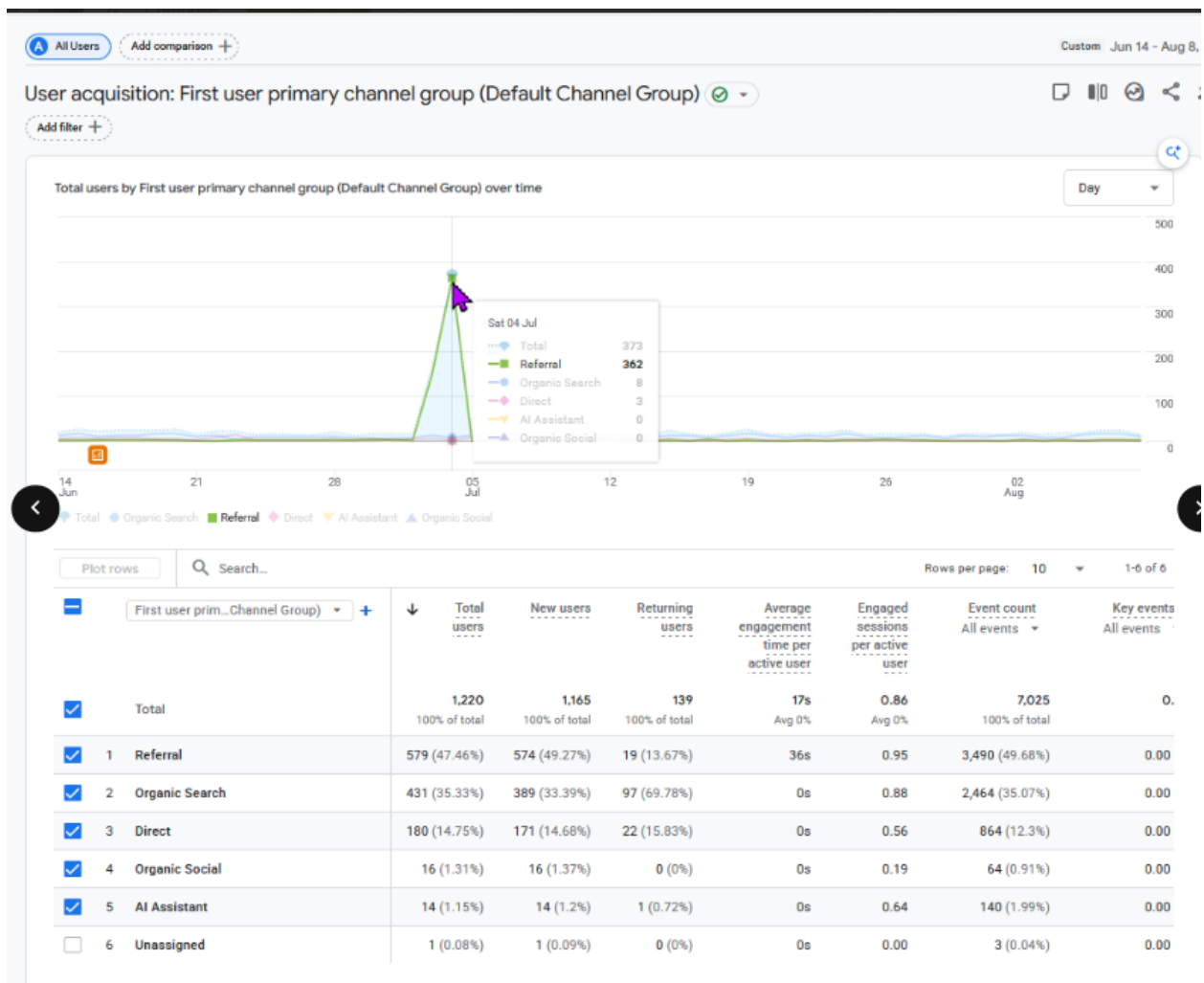

ANALYTICS:

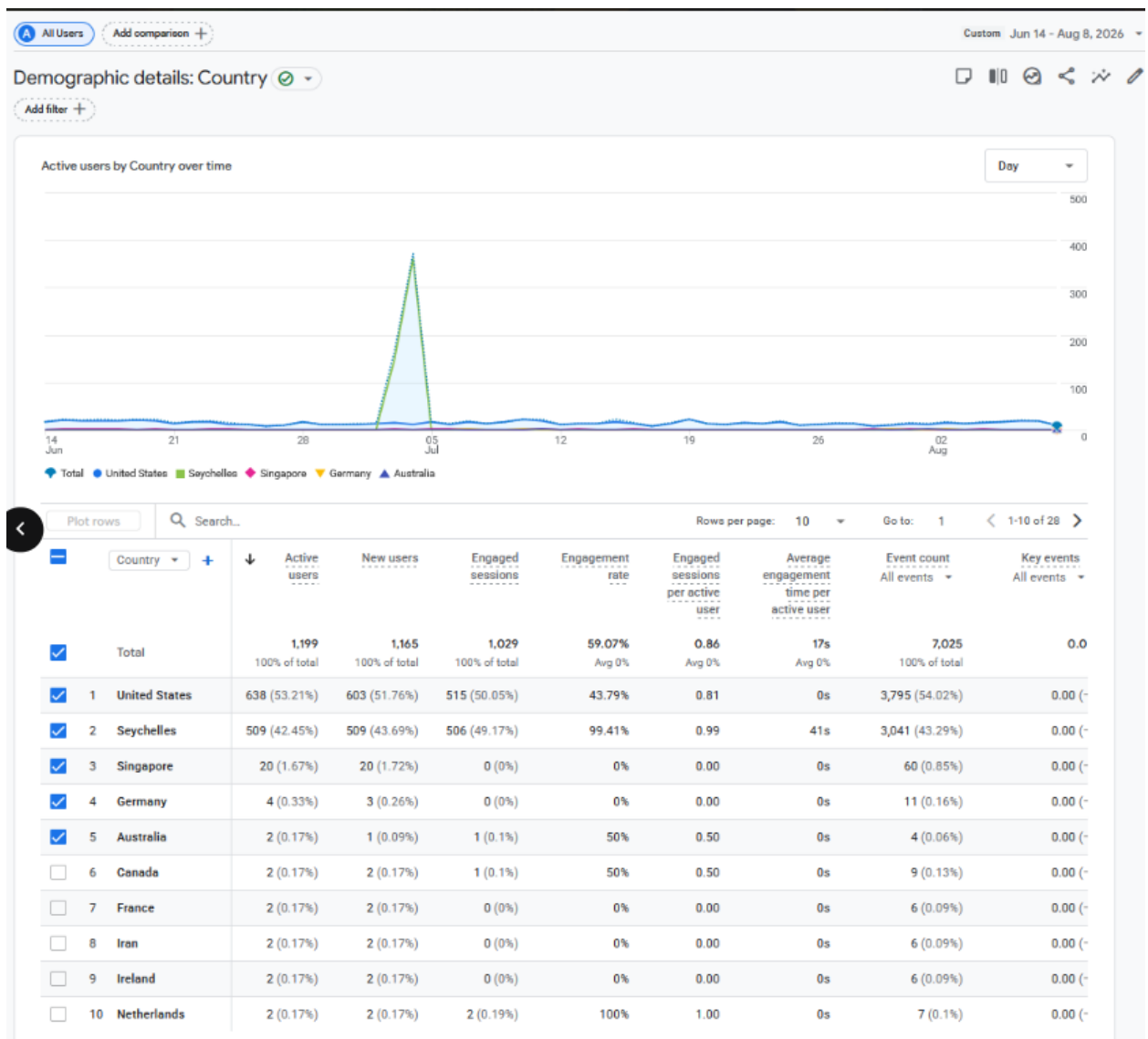

Overview

Campvention was a success. The event ran smoothly from start to finish, and the planning work put in ahead of time by an incredible committee and so many volunteers during the event.

I believe attendance was lower than last year.

Meals provided by areas were: spaghetti by Lakeside, Saturday breakfast by UWANA and Sunday breakfast by Northern.

A few notable contributions by Homegroups to host s'mores and lunch.

Speakers were in my opinion amazing and the message of recovery was shared!

The view was amazing, camp hosts were friendly and the campground accommodating for the size of the event. It's always great to have a lake for recreation near by and was enjoyed by many.

Lessons Learned

- Merchandise: The committee over-purchased merchandise for the event. Future ordering should be scaled back and tied more closely to registration numbers or historical sell-through.
- Meal Costs: Feedback surfaced from some areas that meal costs should be exclusively absorbed by the Campvention committee, rather than shared or passed along elsewhere. This should be addressed and clarified ahead of next year's budgeting.

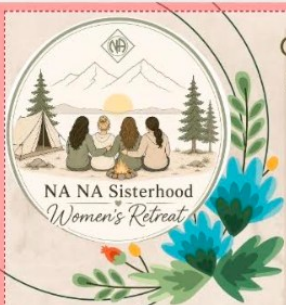
